



## Missouri emissions stations

Vehicle emissions testing continues at all Missouri testing stations through August 2007.

Recently, Senate Bill 583 was passed to change the current centralized vehicle emissions inspection and maintenance (I/M) program in St. Louis. This legislation will revise the state emissions inspection program by creating a decentralized network with widely distributed, low-test volume stations run by local, small businesses rather than a centralized program run by one contractor.

This change will become effective September 1, 2007. As always, please remember to have fleet vehicles tested. It helps clean the air and it's the law. The Gateway Clean Air Program helps to improve air quality in the St. Louis region by testing vehicles for air polluting emissions every two years or when the vehicle is bought or sold.
